These extremely tuneful and often rambunctious works were my own gateway into the world of classical music. And the postlude is an Austrian dance: the waltz "Du und Du" by Johann Strauss.

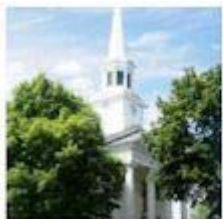
